Redbourn Golf Club Local Rules

- 1) Out of Bounds. (Rule 27)**
Beyond all boundaries of the course. The clubhouse patio, car park and garden. The par 3 course, driving range and practice area. When playing the 6th hole, only the white posts on the left-hand side of the fairway denote out of bounds. When playing the 17th hole, only the white posts on the left-hand side of the fairway denote out of bounds. When playing the 18th hole, only the white posts on the left-hand side of the fairway denote out of bounds. A ball coming to rest adjacent to, or touching a boundary fence or out of bounds marker must be played as it lies. Relief cannot be obtained.
- 2) Water Hazards (Rule 26)**
All areas surrounded by yellow posts whether or not containing water.
- 3) Lateral Water Hazards (Rule 26)**
All water courses marked by red posts whether or not containing water.
- 4) Protection of Young Trees (Rule 24 – 2b)**
Any tree that is staked. If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or the area of intended swing the ball must be lifted, without penalty and dropped within one club length of the nearest point of relief that can be obtained from the tree.
- 5) Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24 – 2b)**
Telegraph poles and support wires. All man-made pathways.

- 6) Ground Under Repair GUR (Rule 25 – 1b)**
Tractor ruts. A teeing area other than that of the hole in play. All temporary greens and any green other than the hole being played. Relief must be taken. (The ball must be dropped off the green at the nearest point of relief).
- 7) Stones in Bunkers**
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions. Rule 24 – 1 applies.
- 8) Overhead Cables**
A ball striking an overhead cable must be replayed. Rule 24-2b applies.
- 9) Fixed Sprinkler Heads**
All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference can be obtained.
- 10) In the Event of Thunder and Lightning**
It is the player's responsibility to leave the course. No klaxon will be sounded.

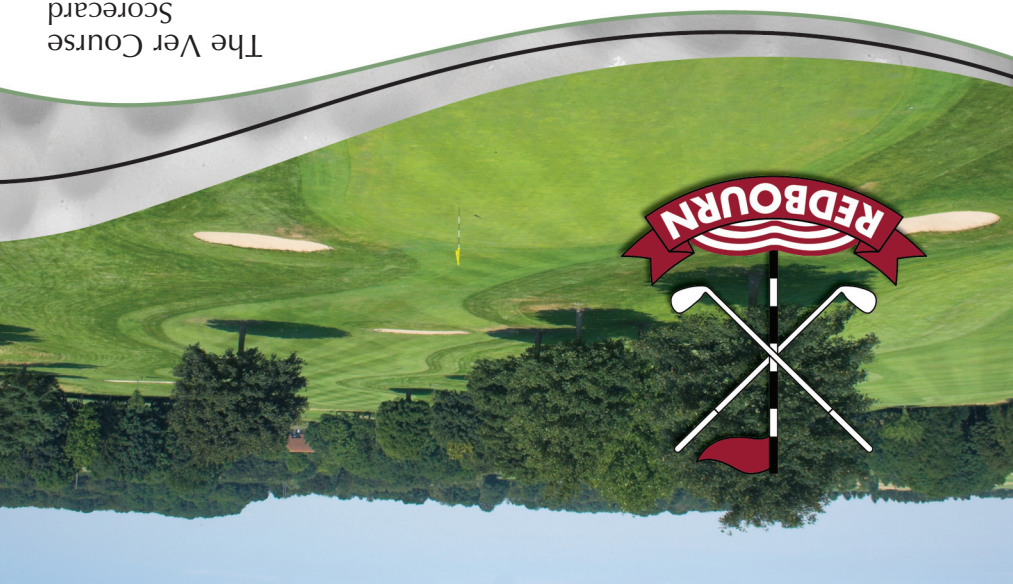
Penalty for Breach of Local Rule

Matchplay – Loss of hole
Strokeplay – Two strokes

Please repair pitchmarks, replace divots and rake bunkers after use. Bunker rakes to be left in the sand with the head of the rake pointing towards the green.
